COOK COUNTY RECORDER OF DEEDS FREE RECORDING of DD-214 Discharge Papers

WHO: All discharged veterans who received a DD-214, and their dependents or designees only. DD-214s are not public records & your identity is protected.

WHAT: Free recording of DD-214s, along with a free certified copy. Our Veterans Service Office can also help find copies of previously-recorded DD-214s (call ahead for pre-1995 recordings).

WHEN: Our Downtown Veterans Service Office is open M-F, 9am-5pm. Satellite office hours may be found at CookRecorder.com

WHERE: DD-214s can be recorded at all satellite offices & our Downtown Office at 118 N. Clark in Chicago.

WHY: DD-214s are not automatically recorded upon discharge, & losing this document can mean a delay in services or a loss of military funeral honors. Recording it at CCRD means you or your loved ones will always be able to quickly retrieve a copy.
